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

Panorama

The weekly Panorama report provides a near-term outlook for North American gas markets in the coming weeks. It includes a sample of pipeline flow data across key shale plays, US production, and trade flows, and demand data covering residential-commercial, power, industrial and pipeline flows into LNG export facilities. The report also reviews expected changes in gas storage, and what is happening with balances and prices in key North American hubs. It provides topical analysis of short-term issues that stand to have a significant impact on the North American gas market.

Outlook


